We will be trekking for five days, which includes some steep sections and scrambling. The visit includes five nights in hotels, four nights camping, with two days spent in Cairo.

Ancient civilisations and desert cultures are combined with hiking to the heights of Mount Sinai, snorkeling in the Red Sea and sailing the Nile. Accompanied by Bedouin guides, the group will trek high into the mountains of the Sinai, including an optional climb on
