A leading Chinese dissident and Release International are calling for Microsoft to follow Google's lead and refuse to censor the Internet in China.

The call came at a conference in London to raise awareness of persecuted Christians in China.

The conference, held jointly by Christian Solidarity Worldwide and Release International, which campaign for persecuted Christians, highlighted the plight of human rights lawyer Gao Zhisheng [pronounced Gow Ji-sheng], who disappeared more than 400 days ago, after defending leaders of the persecuted house church.
